

Schedule for Feb. 9-10 Visit

Friday, Feb. 9 – At 6 p.m., in Dartmouth’s Moore Building Room B03, our visiting Rabbi will lead Friday night services. When asked to describe the service, he wrote: “Unplug from the busy week and welcome Shabbat with soulful singing at Shabbat Unplugged. Bring your family, your voices and your spirits for memorable and inspirational evening.” The entrance to the Moore Building is on Maynard street. Parking is available in the Dartmouth lot across the street.

Saturday, Feb. 10 – At 10 a.m., at the Roth Center, Kol Ha’Emek will hold our traditional Shabbat morning service. Our visiting Rabbi will lead the Shacharit portion of the service, read Torah and give a D’var Torah. Services will be followed at noon by lunch and a presentation by Sara Kobylenski, executive director the Upper Valley Haven, who will speak about poverty in the Upper Valley.

Other events on Saturday, Feb. 10:

- **At 4 p.m., at the Roth Center, the Rabbinic candidate will lead a one-hour study session.**
- **At 5 p.m., at the Roth Center, we will hold a Pajama Havdalah along with a potluck dinner.** Bring a dairy or pareve dish to share and join us for dinner and a guitar-led song-filled Havdalah. Young children are invited to come in their pajamas so they are ready to head to sleep after the ceremony.

Finally, on Sunday, Feb. 11., from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m., at the Roth Center, the visiting Rabbi will host a question and answer session. This is your chance to ask any questions that have not yet been answered.
